| Jurisdiction | Sales Tax on Vehicles |
|-------------------------|---|
| Nunavut | No territorial sales tax |
| Northwest Territories | No territorial sales tax |
| Yukon | No territorial sales tax |
| British Columbia | Same as PEI |
| Alberta | No provincial sales tax |
| Saskatchewan | Dealer – same as PEI, taxes trade difference No provincial sales tax due on used vehicles |
| Manitoba | Dealer – same as PEI, taxes trade difference Provide a refund equal to tax on selling price where a person buys a vehicle and sells another vehicle within a specified period of time. |
| Ontario | Same as PEI |
| Quebec | Same as PEI |
| New Brunswick | Same as PEI |
| Nova Scotia | Same as PEI |
| Newfoundland & Labrador | Same as PEI |
