Dear Mr. Gaudet,

On behalf of my constituents in District 18 Rustico-Emerald, and particularly the residents near the location of the proposed new substation on Bagnall Road, I am writing you with the following requests:

- Ensure that any lighting at the substation is limited to that location as much as possible, to prevent "light pollution" of the surrounding area. For example, use directional lighting, put shades in place, etc.
- Ensure that the substation is surrounded by vegetation – e.g. trees and shrubs – to hide it as much as possible, and make it fit in with the natural surroundings.
- Take steps to reduce any noise emitted by the substation as much as possible, and prevent noise from traveling outward from the substation.
- Work with the province to ensure that the Bagnall Road be paved for easy access year round, and to benefit all vehicles that use this important cross road.
- Provide financial compensation in accordance with fair market value of potential loss in resale price, to the landowners immediately adjacent to and across the road from the substation location.
